<b>Protecting and developing Heritage, Tourism and the Public Realm</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Improving accessibility; to both the countryside and urban areas; Increased signposting and other visual aids</li> <li>• Protecting urban/rural characteristics and iconic historical assets</li> <li>• Environmental improvement e.g. clearing and weeding pathways, planting schemes</li> </ul>
<b>Addressing Social Isolation and Improving Connectivity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Community facilities and services e.g. connected communities centres</li> <li>• Community transport schemes</li> <li>• Improving and promoting use of the waterways, walkways and bridleways, creating walkable neighbourhoods</li> <li>• Care in the community schemes</li> <li>• Improved pedestrian and cycle routes, including accessible routes for those with wheelchairs, frames, buggies, or other mobility aids</li> <li>• Community integration projects</li> </ul>
<b>Improving Health and Wellbeing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Developing Dementia friendly communities</li> <li>• Supporting the vulnerable e.g. those relying on foodbanks, child holiday meals</li> <li>• Improving employability opportunities, raising aspirations and access to work</li> <li>• Services for the elderly, disabled and for mental health</li> <li>• Accessible GP practices</li> </ul>
